SPONSOR AND SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES THE 200th ANNIVERSARY FUND



Inglish High School's academic program offers students a unique curriculum balancing a liberal arts focus along with an introduction to core professions such as: legal, medical, engineering, law enforcement, information science, graphic design, marketing, and business management. The goal for the English High student is to be properly prepared for entrance to a four-year college to pursue their dreams and opportunities, in many cases, the student will be the first in the family to attend college.

Our priority is to raise the student experience at English High School, to increase enrollment and retention and expand its legacy of excellence.

Our fundraising goals are divided into two priority categories:

SCHOLARSHIPS AND LEARNING ENHANCEMENTS:

Increasing Scholarship Support - In this anniversary year we have a goal of raising \$200,000 to allow more scholarships at higher levels for more students.. For a donation of \$25,000 or more, you can have a named scholarship opportunity in your honor or to honor the person of your choice.

Support the Technical Pathways Program - General support is needed for students to earn college credits and develop their abilities in Health Assisting & Wellness, Business, Finance and Entrepreneurship, Programming & Web Development, Legal & Protective Services, Design & Visual Communications

ADVANCING ARTS AND ATHLETICS:

Theater Arts Program - Critical to the school is the refurbishment of the EHS auditorium. At present, the auditorium is inadequate. Sound, audio, lighting, stage and seating improvements are all needed. Principal naming rights for the full cost and secondary permanent recognition on signage for all gifts of \$10,000 and above. Cost: \$500,000


Music Production/Piano Lab - From Haydn to Hip Hop - Equipment, wiring and electrical set up, desktop computers, keyboards, partitions, musical instruments are needed and more. Principal naming rights for the full cost and secondary permanent recognition on signage for all gifts of \$5,000 and above. Cost: \$50,000

Fitness Center - The school's workout space needs minor repairs, paint and a full array of equipment from weights and treadmills to stationary bikes and mats. Principal naming rights for the full cost and secondary permanent recognition on signage for all gifts of \$5,000 and above. Cost: \$25,000

Dance Studio - The dance studio at EHS needs renovation. Paint, mirrors, ballet bars, sound system, costumes and ballet, tap and jazz shoes for reuse are needed. Principal naming rights for the full cost and secondary permanent recognition on signage for all gifts of \$5,000 and above. Cost: \$20,000

Marching Band Uniforms - Uniforms are needed for students. Let's build school pride at English High with colorful new uniforms for the band to wear whether they are marching on the home field or traveling to other schools. Cost: \$10,000
